









Question #25 Total all Areas: How many years have you lived in the Regional District?




Respondents mean length of time lived in RDOS: 19 years













Question#6 During your most recent contact with a Regional District employee, what type of service were you seeking?






Question #7 How would you rate the service provided by the Regional District employee during your most recent contact?







Question#8 Percentage involved in the Activities at <u>Least Once</u> in the previous 12 months?















If the following services were offered on the Regional District web page, would you use them?




Question #17 Total of all Areas - If faced with the following realistic choices, what would you advise the Regional District to do?





Question #19 Total of all Areas - Citizens in the RDOS sometimes use facilities in neighbouring Municipalities. What option would you support?





Question #20 Total of all Areas - The Regional District receives funding from many sources. Which would you prefer the RDOS to increase if additional funding is needed for 2011?






Question #22 Total of all Areas - How do you learn about local government issues?

Methodology

Many local governments now survey their citizens as part of an environmental scan buffet and it was deemed beneficial for the RDOS to join in. It is intended that the 2010 Survey will provide baseline data that the organization can use to work on specific weaknesses in service levels and to compare against in future years to gauge our progress.

A statistically correct Citizen Survey Tool was developed and implemented in July of this year and has now been analyzed by the Survey Committee. For this Citizen Survey to be statistically correct the Regional District needed the survey a minimum of 400 respondents. The number of citizens called in the eight electoral areas was based on the population breakdown of Regional District. Telephone numbers called were randomly generated by reviewing all road names and civic addresses within each electoral area.



1. In which area, or community, do you live?









The following graph illustrates the methods of contact used in each Electoral Area.






6. During your most recent contact with a Regional District employee, what type of service were you seeking?




7. On a scale from 1 to 10 with 1 equal to poor and 10 is equal to excellent please rate the service provided by the Regional District employee during your most recent contact.














8. In the past 12 months, approximately how often did you participate in each of the following activities?








9. On a scale from 1 to 10 with 1 equal to not important and 10 equal to Very Important, how satisfied are you with the following Regional District services?










Electoral Areas: How important and how satisfied are you with the Air Quality?






Electoral Areas: How important and how satisfied are you with the Treatment of invasive, unwanted plants?






Electoral Areas: How important and how satisfied are you with the Development and Subdivision Service?






Electoral Areas: How important and how satisfied are you with the Regulatory Bylaws?






Electoral Areas: How important and how satisfied are you with the Mosquito Control?






Electoral Areas: How important and how satisfied are you with the Parks and Recreational Services?







Electoral Areas - Do you have access to the internet?






12. Do you use e-mail?




Electoral Areas - (Responents with internet) Do you use e-mail?






13. Have you visited the RDOS website?




Electoral Areas - (Responents with internet) Have you visted the Regional District Website?






15. If the following services were offered on the RDOS web page, would you use them?


16. If yes to the above, would you be willing to give your credit card number over a secure connection to purchase these services?





Electoral Areas - Citizens in the RDOS sometimes use facilities in neighbouring Municipalities. What option would you support?






20. The Regional District receives funding from many sources. Which would you prefer the RDOS to increase if additional funding is needed for 2011?



For comparison, the following chart illustrates the actual sources of funding for the RDOS in 2009.






21. What do you think are the three biggest environmental concerns in the Regional District? (i.e., water, air, transit, wildlife)








23. A summary of the newspapers that the residents get updates on local government issues:








